AIRC delegates visit AZT in Munich/Germany

Paint material prices are sky-high, and cost of painting cars and trucks are still rising.



Typically based on price lists of four paint suppliers, AZT calculates the Index100 as an average of the most used materials in a country. The resulting average is used by calculation program suppliers, such as Audatex, GT Motive, Eurotax, and DAT.

Each paint-shop has to calculate its own index by using the AZT system description formula and receives by doing so to possibility to adapt to the market price of its country.

An AIRC delegation, has visited AZT in Munich on 25th May 2022.

Many countries around the world, use the AZT (Allianz Zentrum für Technik) paint program and Index100 in order to calculate paint cost.

AZT collects yearly prices from all countries on paint materials as well as expendable materials for personal protection etc. The data is country specific and such depends on prices in each market.



The dialog about the Index100 situation, has been positive and prosperous for all participants. In the AIRC we focus on transparency, understanding the calculation, and therewith supporting our member organizations.

Since AZT is responsible for the price structure calculation in all countries where AZT is the basis for insurers payment for the work done, the AIRC will continue to follow up the situation. This enables us to represent the interest of several thousand workshops of our member organizations.
